ELDERS

God has called them to shepherd and pastor. Any-one involved in church leadership knows the joys and frustrations of leadership. Some of my best friends and mentors are elders. Through the years, I have observed three recurring themes.

1. Who are the next elders? More specifically, who is even willing or desires the role? Being qualified is a different issue.

2. The challenge of leading as a group. Congregational leadership is plural. It is challenging work (i.e., personalities, experiences, church voices, theology, conscience, etc.). Yet, Christ-centered leaders filled with the Spirit can and must lead together.

3. A narrow view of the pastoral role. Too often, it is limited to praying, visiting the hospital, being friendly people, etc.). I asked a few elder friends and several ministers the question, "On a 1-5 scale with one being the lowest" to what extent are elders engaged in spiritually oriented conversations with members about growing as a disciple, walking into people's sacred places in life, etc.?" No one answered above. Yet, this is what it means to be a "pastor." Way too many elders default to managing the church as an organization rather than pastoring. And it is the managing and often micromanaging aspect of meetings that is a dreaded reality.

A former elder and good friend says it this way— "We are set to fail because we have unknowingly, but intentionally put our leadership (shepherds) in the position of managing. They are now accountable for managing. There is no getting out of it. They are obligated by law to manage. They have a fiduciary obligation to manage. I feel sorry for the position they are put in. This management position appeals to most of us due to our business backgrounds. It's so easy to migrate into a managing space. The gravitational pull is just too strong, especially if you are already charged with this obligation as a default board member of the non-profit."


