"Your pain is not without purpose." These are the words of author Katherine Wolf, a stroke survivor when she was 26 and is now 42. living with significant disabilities. Her book, "Treasures in the Dark" (Thomas

Nelson, 2024) is timely for me. Her and visceral reflections about pain, suffering, doubt and faith are punctuated with vulnerability and hope. The book is 90 reflections on finding bright hope hidden in the hurting.

Her reflections on the chapter entitled, MEETING MYSELF is something I understand and coming to grips with, albeit very slowly.

As the flu and virus season kicks in, I will be limiting my compromised health reality in public places. My doc and the "main doc," Karen, reminds me lovingly to say "No" to preaching and intermingling with church stuff during this time.

So, Katherine's words speak to my soul this day—

"Maybe, like me, you've been forced into a slower pace—whether by sickness or grief or unfulfilled longings—and that's left you feeling useless in a world obsessed with measurable value. Maybe you could use a reminder of the reality of what you are, which is all too often obscured by the expectations of who you think you should be and what you should offer....My value is in God's divine decision to give us life and His never ending commitment to call us beloved. No matter what we do—or don't—accomplish. Today I believe I am worthy of beloved news and belonging, but I couldn't earn it if I tried. If it is true for me, could it be true for you too?" Reflection 15, p 30-31.

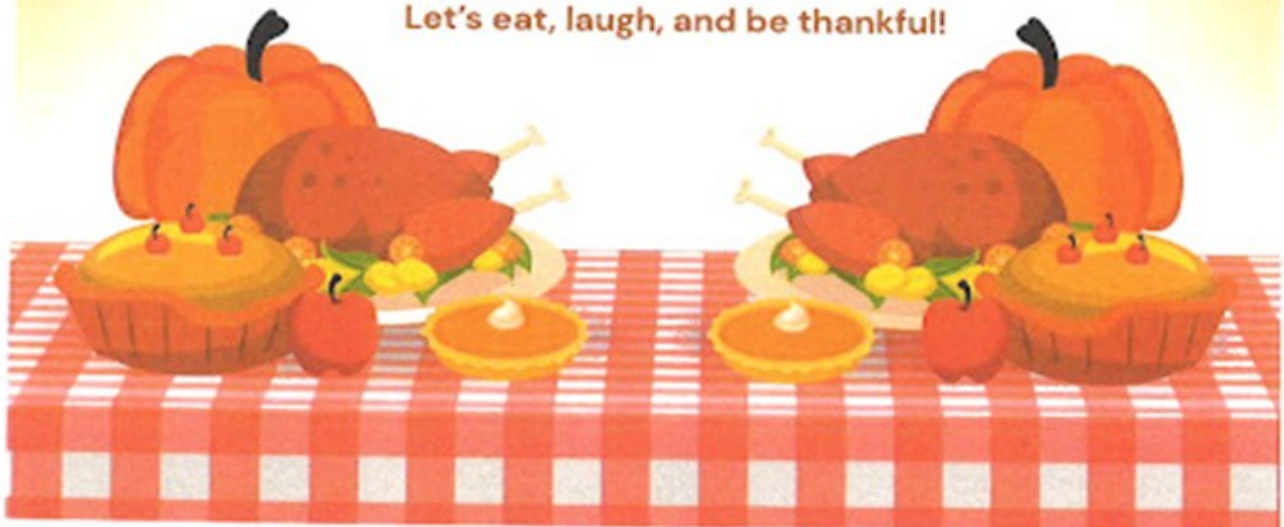
Thanksgiving Potluck
