An Update On My Health

All things considered, I am doing well. I remain on dialysis and just finished the third week of four of training for home hemodialysis. In essence, I will be doing dialysis myself. There is a lot to learn but it will provided convenience and freedom. Even at home, it will take 16-20 hrs of my week. I still have some healing for a sacrum wound before I can have a colostomy reversal and stoma hernia review.

Driving and walking is good. I am actively engaged in HOPE Network with online mentoring, some travel with Interim Ministry, leadership zooms and phone consultations. I am writing frequently on gradyk@substack.com with some of it posted on FB. In addition, I have written for some blogs and journals for HOPE Network, ACU Discernment: The Theology and Practice of Ministry and Misson Alive. Karen and I have put in a small garden and it is great to dig in the earth. It's good for the soul.

Finally, I am slowly working on a book: TRUSTING GOD with the LIFE YOU HAVE: Not the One You Want. It is about my spiritual journey and lessons learned through my chronic illness and the new way of doing ministry.

People ask me what have I learned from all of this. For now, I will quote Esther Smith in her work: Chronic Illness: Walking by Faith.

“Perhaps the most important lesson I have learned is that chronic illness can take away many things, but it can never take away God’s presence. This doesn’t mean we will always feel God’s presence. It does mean that even when you feel forgotten and alone, God is with you. When you are overwhelmed with sorrow, God invited you to tell him how much it hurts. When life doesn’t offer any answers, God offers you himself. Draw near to God because he is your only certainty.” Blessings, GDK

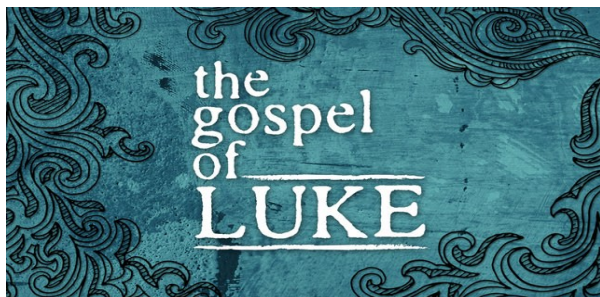
