I Admired Pope Francis

I am not Catholic. Through the years, however, I have appreciated the biblical scholarship and spirituality of several Catholic writers.

As a disciple of Jesus and minister of the Gospel I seek truth applied to life. I know that truth is truth is truth—no matter the context, or who says it. Scripture is the standard.

There was much to admire about Pope Francis—humility, humor and intentional accessibility to people. ABC News special this week, A Pope for the People was truthful, insightful and fair. His request to be buried in a simple wooden casket symbolized his philosophy of life and ministry. He was an international spiritual leader. Unity, peace and mercy guiding his steps into a broken and war-torn world. It is noteworthy that he saw and touched people as humans not as liberal and conservative labels. When he was criticized he often appealed to the life of Jesus for his “liberal” actions. To many, he was a breath of fresh air blowing in the winds of institutional angst, even chaos. To the establishment of not only Catholicism, but also of evangelicals, he was a threat.

In a sense, what Francis did was take the *pontiff* out of *pontificate* through service to others. If I ever got to visit with him I would gladly receive his blessing. I know we differed on some doctrinal and theological perspective. What I cannot argue with though is his primary emphasis that the gospel of Jesus Christ is not merely a doctrine to believe, but a way of life.

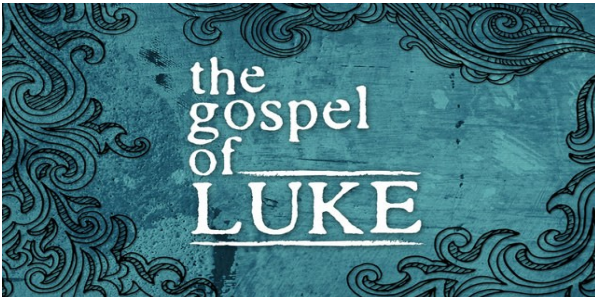
