Isaiah

I have been dwelling in Isaiah as of late. The “BIBLE” of the first disciples of Jesus was what we know as the Old Testament. The first Jewish Christians only had the O.T., and oral stories of Jesus passed around for the first 20-30 years until the manuscript of Mark’s gospel was circulated, read and heard. Bottom line—Jesus as LORD, KING, PRIEST, sacrifice, redeemer, reconciler, healer became the lens of “Bible” they had heard all their lives. Psalms were their prayers to God in new ways. They understood the “O.T.”, as more than back then, but now. No dull history. It was dynamic, alive and relevant with Jesus as the filter. God was new every morning.

Isaiah 33 addresses deliverance from Israel’s foes, particularly Assyria and I wonder, just wonder, how early disciples applied it in light of Jesus and living in the shadows of the Roman Empire. I like the way Peterson’s THE MESSAGE translates it. And it seems very relevant for this day in our own time.

*God, treat us kindly. You’re our only hope.
First thing in the morning, be there for us!
When things go bad, help us out!
You spoke in thunder and everyone ran.
You showed up and nations scattered.
Your people, for a change, got in on the loot,
picking the field clean of the enemy spoils.
God is supremely esteemed. His center holds.
Zion brims over with all that is just and right.
God keeps your days stable and secure—
salvation, wisdom, and knowledge in surplus,
and best of all, Zion’s treasure, Fear-of-God.*


