## “Advance Care Planning: What I need to know”

Advance care planning is the process of preparing legal documents that allow you to name someone to speak for you and make your medical decisions if you cannot speak for yourself. No matter your age or circumstances, this course will help you complete legal documents to communicate your wishes to your loved ones and medical care providers.

### Attend this course to:

- Learn about Texas Law and how to ensure your wishes are met.
- Discuss how to talk with your family, and those close to you, about your future healthcare choices.
- Prepare the legal documents to share with your family and your health care team.

### Course Description *This is an In-person course*

This **FREE course** will last approximately 2 hours and will explore the State of Texas Advance Directive documents including the Medical Power of Attorney and Directive to Physicians (Also known as a Living Will).

Before the class, we'll ask you to complete a short survey. Your privacy is important to us—your information will *not* be shared. We use the responses only to understand how well we're doing and to make our program better for everyone.
