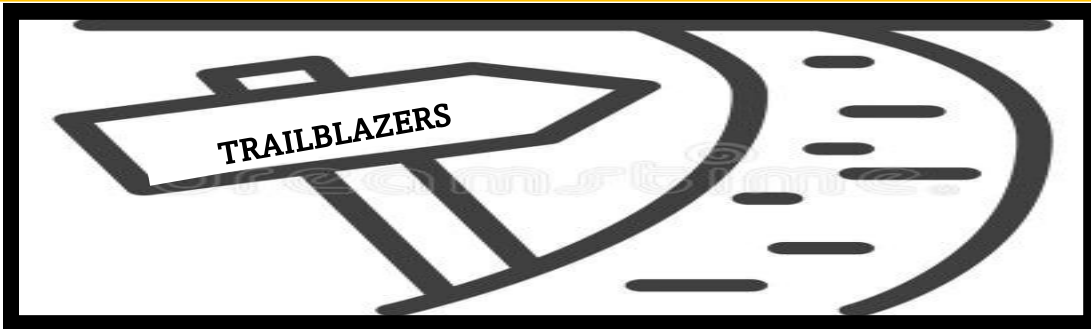

Anxiety is ubiquitous—it is everywhere from all directions around the globe and more significantly, inside of us.

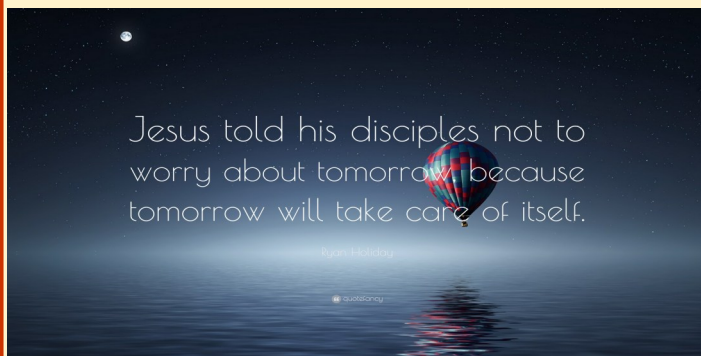
It is no wonder Jesus addressed fear, worry, anxiety consistently and pointed us to consider the lilies of the field.
