I guess it fell off and went under my car when I was cleaning out the car last week. It has been loose on my finger for a while. Time to get it resized.

Last week, I attended a Kidney Social Summit in Dallas with about 70 other people...lunch, vendors and testimonies about transplants as well as docs taking questions. It was very encouraging. I plan to walk a 5K (3.1 miles). It's not a long distance unless you have some health issues. I will make it. It is Oct 3 sponsored by National Kidney Foundation. Watch for an invitation soon from me to sponsor and join my team—THE GRADY BUNCH. Ironically, the last time I was called by this was as a youth minister in McAlester, Okla as my youth group made me Asher that had that phrase. So, here we go. I am still healing the sacrum wound and praying for a transplant in the next year or sooner. Thanks for your support and prayers.

Also yesterday, I attended a Memorial Service for Dr. Gary Gosdin (Thoracic Surgeon). It was a great celebration of life. He loved God, his family, friends and served as Lt Col in the U.S. Army and Reserve. He was an expert in WW II history. For the last 26 years he endured many surgeries as a result of a car accident which forced early retirement. His resilience did not stop him even in a wheel chair for doing life, serving as an elder for a while, hosting a men's Bible Study. Thank you, Gary. You always made me think, provided insight and support. His wife, D'awn is a beautiful, caring "Saint" in every way.

Years ago, I was with a family very late one night in CCU. As I went by a room I saw Dr. Gosdin beside a bed of a critical patient with his head on his hand of the bed rail. I did not wake him. Later, I asked him and he said, "It was a long night of surgery and the patient was very critical." This says it all.

Rest well, my brother. No pain, walker or cane

➤ Sunday, June 21 — **The Young Adults** will meet in room 109. Charlie DeLong is leading the class.



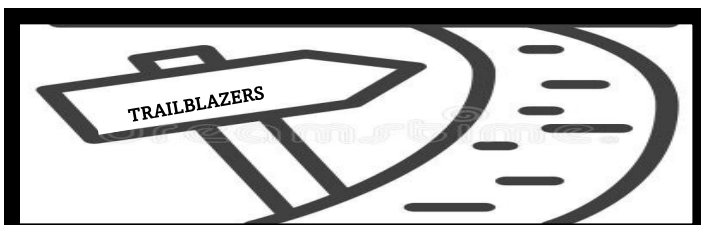
➤ Sunday, June 21— **Worship Service begins at 10:00.** David Bearden will be giving a Father’s Day sermon.

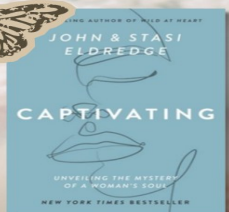
